

Snapchat Safety Skills to Teach Your Child

Go through these skills with your child before they start using Snapchat.

Safety Skill

- 1 Save Evidence:** If someone sends you something that makes you uncomfortable, save the message or take a screenshot so it doesn't disappear.
- 2 Block & Report the User:** You can block and report anyone who makes you uncomfortable in Snapchat. To do so, tap on the user's profile > three dots > Manage Friendship > Block or Report.
- 3 Recognize Red Flags:** If someone asks for private photos, wants you to keep secrets from parents, or says they'll hurt themselves if you stop talking, it's not normal. Tell me right away.
- 4 Protect Personal Information:** Avoid sharing your location, school, address, daily routine, real name, or phone number with anyone you don't know.
- 5 Be Careful with Strangers:** Only add people who you know in real life and don't accept friend requests from strangers on Snapchat.
